We've worked with social workers Jasmine and Kim for our respective adoptions, and they were both WONDERFUL at diplomacy, comfort, and showing care throughout the process. During our most recent adoption Kim spent time with me in the hospital. I found her to be a loving and open person, with a beautiful heart for adoption and for people. She even spent time talking to me about my own adoption, meeting my birth mother for the first time, and how to work through complicated emotions and set boundaries that are comfortable to us both to give us time to grow in our relationship.



The Lord has truly blessed my journey, guiding me as a devoted husband to a remarkable, God-fearing wife, a father to two cherished daughters, a time as a pilot in the Air Force, a committed church minister, and now, for 22 years, as the Director of Christian Family Services (CFS). Not only pregnancy centers around the state, but hospitals that our moms have delivered in that were so impressed with CFS and the care given to each mom that they often "refer" moms who are considering adoption at the last minute to contact us, or they contact us when they have a Safe Haven baby.

A Safe Haven for Newborns is dedicated to saving the precious lives of newborns from the dangers of abandonment and assisting pregnant girls and women in crisis.

Florida's Safe Haven Law allows mothers, or fathers of an unharmed newborn, approximately seven days old or less, to be left with someone at a hospital, fire rescue station or emergency medical service station. Parents get anonymity and won't face criminal prosecution unless the infant has any signs of abuse or neglect.

The hospital contacts a participating private adoption agency who will then arrange placement of the newborn with a waiting family. CFS waiting families have received Safe Haven infants over the years.
